

## So much comfort from such a small product.

The Grundfos Comfort System uses a small (about the size of a softball) but powerful pump at your water heater to keep the water in your line hot. Then a valve at your faucet provides constant hot water availability.

There's even a timer on the pump to make it more efficient during downtime, like nights or midday. It's quiet, maintenance-free, and keeps your water oh so comfy.



## You're in hot water now.

The Grundfos Comfort System does what your water heater can't do. It delivers hot water to your showers and sinks immediately.


No waiting for the warm-up. No wasted time or water. Just hot water on demand.



## Waste not, wait not.

Without the Grundfos Comfort System, about two or three gallons of cold water runs off before hot water can make it from your heater to your tap. In a family of four, that's thousands of gallons a year wasted.

The Grundfos System saves all of that, which makes your hot shower a little more comfortable.



## How does it work?

When your faucet is off, water cools in your pipes.

Water that cools overnight becomes a cold shower the next morning, because your faucet has to "run off" all the water between your heater and the spigot.

With the Grundfos Comfort System water circulate back to the heater so it's always hot and comfortable, from the moment you turn the knob.
